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## Bling Scarf

This easy and quick lace scarf adds a touch of "bling" sequins to your outfit making it suitable for any occasion! The pattern is easily expanded in multiples of two stitches using more yarn so you can have as much bling as you like.

Yarn: 1 skein [Southwest Trading Company "Yang"](#), 80% Wool, 20% Silk, 20% Bamboo; wrap thread 100% silk with metallic sequins; 50gm/55m (60yds)

Needles: US 8 (5mm), gauge is not important.

Dimensions: Blocked approximately 6" x 48"

### Stitch Abbreviations:

k1 - knit one stitch

yoo - yarn over needle twice, knit as one stitch on the following row

k2tog - knit two stitches together

### Pattern :

Row 1: k1, \*k1, yoo, k2tog\* repeat between \*, end k1

Row 2: knit

### Instructions:

The sequins in this yarn require knitting loosely throughout.

Cast On 20 stitches. Knit one row. Begin pattern rows repeating until you have about one yard of yarn remaining following Row 2. Bind off all stitches. Work in yarn tails. Wash gently in lukewarm water, stretch and block to dry. The pattern has an inherent tendency to create diagonal ends (for reasons I cannot explain) which add to the overall design surprisingly.
